Responsibilities

• Teach 12 hours per semester of elementary education courses at the undergraduate level;

- A minimum of three years of teaching experience in pre-K-6 schools;
- Evidence of quality higher education or equivalent teaching in teacher education.

Minimum Qualifications - Education or training

Candidates are required to have a master's degree or higher in Elementary Education or related field with at least 18 credit hours of graduate coursework in Curriculum & Instruction by June 2024.

- Experience with creation and implementation of online learning;
- Experience with marketing and student recruitment;
- Experience with student teacher/practica supervision;
- Experience with school-university partnerships;

- Experience in teaching blended or online classes as well as face-to-face classes;
