- Identification of suitable teaching material and resources for children to explore, manipulate and use both in learning activities and in imaginative play
- Provides basic care and care-giving activities
- Uses a wide range of teaching methods to enhance the child abilities
- Observes and conducts developmental assessment, both formal and informal, of each child in the classroom
- Maintains constant communication with parents to provide updates on child's learning, curriculum and to provide resources to enhance children's learning and development
- Identification of behavioral, developmental or health problems, and implementation of need-based remedial activities
- Adherence with teaching standards and safety regulations as established by State and National Child Care Regulations
- Maintains student records and provide reports as required
- Supervises, trains, evaluates and plans assignments for student trainees and field placement students
- Maintains ethical code of conduct in compliance with the NAEYC and FERPA
- Other related duties as assigned.
