The department was established by reorganizing existing faculty from within SEAS and currently numbers 13 faculty. It intends to grow by the recruitment of tenured faculty with expertise in engineering education, pedagogy, and assessment.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach courses at the graduate and undergraduate levels, mentor graduate students, advise students at all levels and maintain an active research program. The successful candidate for an Associate Professor or Professor position should have a record of scholarly accomplishments, teaching experience and a sustained externally funded research program. We are particularly looking for candidates with a proven track record of publication and funding in engineering education, as well as experience in scaling and translation of engineering research to classroom practice. Desirable areas of research expertise include but are not limited to, one or more of the following: diversity/inclusiveness/persistence; pedagogy; the science of learning; assessment and engineering epistemology.
