- An earned terminal degree (Ph.D. or Ed.D.) from an accredited institution of higher education in Applied Linguistics, TESOL, Bilingual Education, or a closely related field or a closely related field by September 1, 2023

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- At the Associate Rank, demonstrate a record of excellence in teaching, research, and service, as well as a potential to procure external funding to support scholarship
- Strong, explicit commitment to educational equity and social justice for bi/multilingual students
- At least 3 years teaching experience with bilingual/multilingual or emergent bilingual (EB) students in PK12 classrooms in the US, preferably in urban or suburban settings
- Demonstrated commitment to working in an environment devoted to collaboration, collegiality, professional development, diversity, scholarly inquiry, student learning, civic responsibility, and respect for all people
- Demonstrated commitment to working with PK12 schools and underrepresented students and families

We acknowledge that Rowan University rests on Native American land that is part of the traditional territory of the Lenni-Lenape, called Lenapehoking. During the colonial era and early federal period, many were removed west and north, but some also remain among the continuing historical tribal communities of the region: The Nanticoke Lenni-Lenape Tribal Nation; the Ramapough Lenape Nation; and the Powhatan Renape Nation, The Nanticoke of Millsboro Delaware, and the Lenape of Cheswold Delaware. We recognize their historic desire for harmony among the indigenous people of this land, descendants of immigrants, and descendants of the enslaved brought here forcibly, “as long as the rivers and creeks flow, and the sun, moon, and stars shine” (Lenape Chief Tamanend). We acknowledge that we work, teach, and learn here, and bear responsibility to engage meaningfully in relationship with the tribal community of the Lenni-Lenape people on their homeland.
