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Position Details

The Department of Education in the College of Social Sciences, Mathematics and Education at The University of Tampa invites applications for a tenure-track position in Education at the rank of Assistant Professor starting in August 2024.

The University of Tampa is a medium-sized, comprehensive, residentially based private institution of 10,566 undergraduate and graduate students. The University is ideally situated on a beautiful 110-acre campus next to the Hillsborough River, adjacent to Tampa's dynamic central business district, a growing, vibrant, diverse metropolitan area. UT reflects this vibrancy; with 24 consecutive years of enrollment growth, UT boasts 300 student organizations, a multicultural student body from 50 states and most of the world's countries, and a "Top Tier" ranking in U.S. News and World Report.

Responsibilities for this position include teaching courses in the Instructional Design & Technology graduate program (during the day and in the evening); developing a research agenda related to the field and disseminating results in publications and presentations; advising graduate students; supervising interns in the Instructional Design & Technology program; addressing program needs in the department related to instructional design and educational technology; and building collaborative relationships with colleagues in other disciplines both across campus and within the college to broaden the scope of the program in recruiting students.

While the teaching responsibilities of this position are primarily at the graduate level, there are opportunities at the undergraduate level as well.

Candidates are expected to show a commitment to excellence in teaching, engaging students in learning beyond the classroom, and have demonstrated scholarship in their area of expertise. Other responsibilities include student advising and service to the department, college, and University.

Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled. For full consideration, your application should be submitted no later than Oct 6, 2023. Salary is competitive and commensurate with experience.

Qualifications

Applicants must have a terminal degree in instructional design, instructional technology, instructional systems, or a terminal degree in a related discipline reflected by coursework and scholarship.

ABD applicants will be considered if their degree is complete by August 2024. The ideal candidate should have teaching experience in face-to-face, hybrid, and online modes at the college level and be

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able to design, develop, and teach graduate and undergraduate-level courses. Familiarity and/or experience with K-12 education preferred.
