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Basic Education to persons needing a high school equivalency diploma along with an entry level career pathway and/or English language training for English Language Learners. This is a non-benefit eligible, grant funded position.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- * Actively engage the Catholic Franciscan mission and identity of Marian University by modeling the Franciscan Sponsorship Values and honoring the legacy of the founding congregation through transformative education, unity in diversity, leadership through service, integrating faith and life, and institutional policies.
- * Plan lessons and curriculum based on the learning needs of culturally diverse and mul7-skill level students
- * Use research-based instructional strategies
- * Teach employability skills such as teamwork, leadership, and workplace values
- * Embed workforce communication, math, science, and economic skills within the curriculum
- * Co-Teach general knowledge and skills required to effectively navigate within the workplace
