We will also prioritize candidates who can demonstrate connections between their research, teaching, and service, and the needs of marginalized and underserved populations.

Responsibilities include:

- Conduct exemplary research, commensurate with Research 1 tenure track faculty appointments, leading to the development of innovative ideas and publications in prominent scholarly outlets.
- Pursue extramural funding for research initiatives.
- Teach two courses per semester at the graduate level.
- Advise and mentor graduate students, including chairing and serving on doctoral dissertation committees.
- Support efforts to recruit Ed.M. and Ph.D. students.
- Fulfill service responsibilities related to program, departmental, and university affiliations.

Appointments are for a ten-month academic year beginning in the Fall of 2025.
