Old Dominion University's Department of Educational Leadership & Workforce Development seeks applications for a tenure track Assistant Professor to support the undergraduate Training Specialist program and graduate Workforce & Organizational Development program. Candidates with **expertise in human resource development and training, instructional systems and learning technologies, workforce development, and industrial-organizational psychology** are encouraged to apply. This is a 10-month appointment beginning July 25, 2025 with opportunities for summer employment.
