Job Description

The Graduate School of Education (GSE) at the University at Buffalo, The State University of New York, invites applications for a visionary leader to serve as Associate Dean for Teacher Education. This is a full-time, tenured position at the rank of Associate Professor or Professor. The Associate Dean for Teacher Education, a member of the Dean's Leadership Team, will serve as the point person for all matters related to teacher preparation including establishing a vision for UB Teacher Education, and engaging with local, statewide, SUNY, and national partners.
