Building on the recommendations of the <u>Anti-Black Racism</u> Campus Climate Review, TMU has implemented this program to expand and advance Black scholarship and intellectual traditions, and support the academic endeavours of the Black community.

Fellowship Details:

Available fellowships: up to four (4) beginning September 1, 2025

• Amount: \$70,000/year plus benefits

• Duration: 24 months

Field: Open

• Deadline to apply: March 31, 2025

• Decision: July 2025

Eligibility

- Scholars who self-identify as Black (of African descent; for example, Africans and African heritage people from the Caribbean, Americas, Europe).
- Completion of a PhD or PhD-equivalent within the last three years prior to the application deadline, or PhD expected by the planned start date of the fellowship.
- Can hold the fellowship by September 1, 2025 for two years.
- Successful applicants must be eligible to work in Canada by the start of the Postdoctoral position.
 International applicants may apply; however, successful international applicants will require a work permit and Canadian Social Insurance Number in order to take up the postdoctoral position.
 Exceptional start dates may be negotiated in relation to the permit and visa process timelines.
- Applicants must be associated with a current or proposed supervisor who holds a tenured or tenure-track faculty position at TMU. Applications must include a letter of support from the proposed supervisor.
- This funding cannot be held concurrently with another major fellowship.
- Applicants cannot hold a faculty position or be on leave from such a position.
- Applicants cannot hold, or have previously held a TMU Postdoctoral Fellowship for Black Scholars.
- Applicants must submit proof of completion of degree before the fellowship commences.
