- Works closely with the Testing Center to ensure that HSE students are appropriately scheduled for the GED Exam and collaborates with designated Student Services staff to assist HSE students with succession plans to either advance into postsecondary education, training opportunities, and/or a job.
- Builds on and implements curriculum tailored to content on the GED Exam to be delivered in both a virtual model and, when possible, in an onsite classroom instruction model.
- Participates in regularly scheduled meetings related to HSE with other EOCs and community organizations offering HSE programming.
- Uses effective and timely communication strategies and methods to communicate with various stakeholders regarding the HSE Program.
