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Old Dominion University's Department of STEM Education and Professional Studies seeks applications for one full-time tenure track Assistant or Associate Professor (10-month appointment with opportunity for summer employment) in Occupational and Technical Studies in the undergraduate Training Specialist Program and the graduate Human Resources-Training Program beginning August 2023. Candidates with expertise in business and industry training, workforce development, and instructional design are encouraged to apply. The salary is commensurate with qualifications and

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experience.

Responsibilities include: (1) producing high quality research for publication in peer-reviewed journals, (2) teaching and developing undergraduate and graduate face-to-face and web-based courses, (3) seeking external and internal funding to support scholarship endeavors; (4) advising undergraduate and graduate students and directing doctoral committees, and (5) participating in program growth and improvement.
