- Maintains constant communication with parents to provide updates on child's learning, curriculum and to provide resources to enhance children's learning and development
- Identification of behavioral, developmental or health problems, and implementation of needbased remedial activities
- Adherence with teaching standards and safety regulations as established by State and National Child Care Regulations
- · Maintains student records and provide reports as required
- Supervises, trains, evaluates and plans assignments for student trainees and field placement students
- Maintains ethical code of conduct in compliance with the NAEYC and FERPA
